






# Stream 1: Paper and Fibres

Materials	Examples	What to Know
	<b>Paper, any colour</b> Flour bags, prescription bags, paper produce bags, Notepads, file folders, other printed materials, Newspapers, flyers, brochures, magazines, Greeting cards, envelopes, gift boxes.	Empty Place shredded paper in a tied, clear plastic bag Remove rope handles from bags Do not include books
	<b>Cardboard</b> Pizza boxes, corrugated cardboard, moving boxes, shoe boxes	Flatten Fold down to 60cm x 60cm
	<b>Boxboard</b> Cereal boxes, tissue boxes, egg cartons, toilet paper / paper towel rolls	Empty Flatten
	<b>Paper laminate packaging</b> Pet food bags, food service paper bags, plates	Empty, free from food residue
	<b>Flexible Plastic Packaging</b> Bags used for dry cleaning, bread bags, overwrap (paper towel, toilet paper and bottles), coffee bags, deli pouches, chip bags, bubble wrap, snack wrappers, cereal liner bags, plastic gift bags	Empty, free from food residue Bundle all flexible plastics into one flexible plastic bag

# Stream 2: Containers

Materials	Examples	What to Know
	<b>Cartons</b> Beverage, dairy and juice cartons, coffee creamers, sugar containers, soup and sauce cartons, molasses cartons, laundry and cleaning cartons	Rinse Lids on
	<b>Paper laminate containers and cups</b> Spiral cans, cookie dough packaging, ice cream containers, hot and cold beverage cups	Empty, free from food residue Remove lids
	<b>Plastic Containers</b> Laundry detergent and household cleaner jugs, shampoo, soap and body wash bottles, salad dressing and condiment bottles, mouth wash bottles, plastic beverage bottles, food trays and containers, plastic cups, plastic tubs and lids, toothpaste tubes, deodorant containers, hand cream tubes, small item packaging, sanitizer bottles, plant pots, black plastic containers, clamshell packaging, molded retail packaging, cutlery	Empty, free from residue Lids on Do not include industrial plastics, toys or furniture
	<b>Metal</b> Food cans, metal lids, tins, beverage cans, tea and coffee tins, cookie tins, candle tins	Empty, free from food residue Do not include paint cans
	<b>Aluminum (foil and trays)</b> Aluminum foil, pie plates, frozen food trays	Rinse Ball up aluminum foil
	<b>Aerosol containers (for food or on hair/skin)</b> Food spray, hairspray, air fresheners, shaving cream, deodorant	Empty Do not include aerosols with toxic, corrosive or flammable materials
	<b>Glass containers, clear and coloured glass</b> Food containers, jars and bottles, cosmetic containers, spice bottles, oil and vinegar bottles, non-alcoholic beverage containers	Empty, free from food residue Lids off Do not include glassware or dishes
	<b>Foam packaging</b> Meat trays, takeout containers, cups, plates, bowls, foam packaging for produces	Empty, free from food residue Remove film wrap and absorbent pads from meat trays
